 - Sponsor Training segment immediately following Walks
 - A peek behind the scenes
 - a. Using the web site as a structure (Hot spot?)- quick tour of the workings of the community & how they can plug in
 - b. Short word from a recent experienced team member- what teaming meant to them, basic outlines of talks were provided, complete schedule of the walk made available for review in back
 - Obtain Fourth Day Speakers for Base Gatherings not following walks
- 2. Recruit Local Hosted Gathering Sites and Teams

Local Hosted Gatherings will provide their own leadership.

The ACLD will lift up any Community Announcements or business at the appropriate time as agreed with the Hosting Community Team

- 3. Prepare following originals for Walk 4th Day Packets
 - Envelope Cover invitation for each Walk
